This week, we have the same problem for Junior, Middle and Senior students, it is designed for 5-16 year olds.

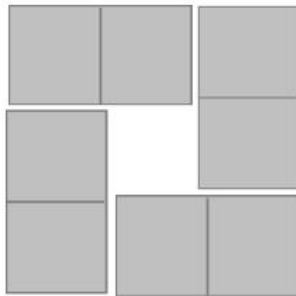

Alternatively, you can just use the information provided below to solve this problem.

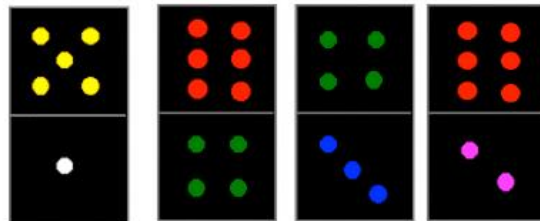
4 DOM
